Investing in Renewable Energy

Born in 1956. LI Junfeng graduated from the Shandong Mining Institute in 1982.

LI Junfeng lectures as a professor and chairs the Academic Committee of the Energy Research Institute (ERI) in Beijing. He is the General Secretary of the Chinese Renewable Industrial Association, Vice-Chairman of the Global Wind Energy Council, Vice-Chairman of the Renewable Energy Policy Network for the 21st Century (REN 21) and Chief Editor of Energy Law in China. He serves as the facilitator of the Renewable Energy & Energy Efficiency Partnership (REEEP) in East Asia and is engaged in various projects concerning the development of renewable energy in China, working with organisations such as United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), Global Environment Facility (GEF) and the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development. LI Junfeng is furthermore involved with the Clean Development Mechanism (CDM), technology transfer and carbon trade issues, being responsible for the first CDM project in China and currently acts as Deputy Director of the National Development and Reform Commission.

During the course of his work, he has chaired the sustainable energy task force of the Chinese National High Technology Programme and is a driving force in the design of Chinese renewable energy law.

He has published extensively on issues related to green house gas emissions, renewable energies and carbon trade in China.
