Born in 1973. Marius Ronge graduated from the University of St. Gallen in 1997 and received his Doctorate there in 2001. He also holds a Master of Business Administration with concentrations in finance and entrepreneurship from the University of Chicago Graduate School of Business.

During his studies, he worked in the U.S., Europe and China, interning with Robert Bosch GmbH, a Siemens AG joint-venture in China, The Boston Consulting Group and Goldman Sachs. From 2000 to 2005, Marius Ronge worked in McKinsey & Company's Chicago office, advising Fortune 500 and middle-market companies across a wide variety of industries, such as air transport, travel, automotive parts and consumer goods on issues of strategy and operations. In 2005, Marius Ronge founded Alpha 6 Management LLC, a Chicago-based private equity firm focusing on companies with revenues of USD 10–100 million. He is also a partner at Franck Advisors, a consulting firm, where he advises leading companies on purchasing, supplier development, supply chain, manufacturing operations and product design-to-cost strategies and implementation.
