### The Dependence on Foreign Oil

Born in 1957. Mohamed Hamel graduated from the *Ecole Polytechnique de Paris* in 1979 and the *Ecole des Mines de Paris* in 1981.

In 1983, he started his professional career as engineer within the production division of Sonatrach, the Algerian national oil and gas company, focusing on reservoir modelling. He moved to the exploration division as director responsible for geology, geophysics and well evaluation in 1988. Five years later, he joined the corporate centre as director of economics and planning and was named vice president in charge of strategy, planning and economics in 1998. Mohamed Hamel also served as member of the board of Sonatrach. Since 2002, he has been Head of the Energy Studies Department of the Organisation of Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC).
