### The Dependence on Foreign Oil

Born in 1944. Yoshinori Imai graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in economics from Keio University, Tokyo, in 1968.

Subsequently, he joined NHK Japan Broadcasting Corporation as television and radio reporter. Between 1978 and 1986, Yoshinori Imai worked as correspondent in Washington D.C. and business correspondent for NHK News. After serving as presenter of NHK's *Morning and World News* until 1989, he returned to the U.S. as NHK's New York correspondent. In 1990, Yoshinori Imai was appointed editor of Business News and managing editor of *Japan Business Today* before again presenting NHK's *Morning News* between 1993 and 1995, when he was re-located to London to become bureau chief of the NHK General Bureau for Europe and head of News Operations in Europe, Middle East and Africa. Three years later, he returned to Japan as executive presenter and analyst for NHK News. Between 2000 and 2003, he served as director-general at the NHK international planning & broadcasting department. Since 2003, Yoshinori Imai has been Executive Editor at NHK Japan.
