Born in 1960. Gabriella Stern graduated from Yale University, where she earned both a Bachelor and Master degree. In 1983, she started to work for the Omaha World-Herald in Nebraska as a reporter and in 1985 reported from the paper's Washington bureau. From 1986 to 1987, she served as bureau chief in the state capital in Lincoln, Nebraska.

She joined Dow Jones in 1991 as a reporter in the Pittsburgh bureau of The Wall Street Journal, where she covered banking and consumer products. After serving as deputy bureau chief in Detroit from 1994, Gabriella Stern moved to New York in 1997 as a news editor for the Money & Investing group. In 1998, she became The Wall Street Journal's news editor in New York for health and science.

Gabriella Stern was re-located to London in 2000 where she has been Dow Jones Newswires' Senior Editor for Europe, the Middle East and Africa (EMEA). She has overall responsibility for editorial operations in this region.
