*Geboren 1941. Lord Griffiths studierte an der London School of Economics, an der er anschliessend von 1965 bis 1976 lehrte.*

*Er war Mitglied des Lehrkörpers der City University in London von 1976 bis 1985 und Dekan der Business School zwischen den Jahren 1982 und 1985. Er wurde 1983 zum Direktor der Bank of England und 1985 zum Head of the Prime Minister's Policy Unit ernannt, mit Verantwortlichkeiten für domestic policy-making. 1991 wurde ihm die Würde eines Life Peer verliehen. Lord Griffiths ist Vice Chairman von Goldman Sachs International sowie Director von Times Newspaper Holdings Ltd, Telewest Communications Group Limited und Herman Miller Inc. Er agiert ausserdem als Chairman des Centre for Policy Studies und des Archbishop of Canterbury's Lambeth Fund.*

*Lord Griffiths publizierte und lehrte in den Themenbereichen Ökonomie, Öffentlichkeitsarbeit, Ethik und Betriebswirtschaft.*

Born in 1941. Lord Griffiths studied at the London School of Economics and subsequently taught there from 1965 until 1976.

He lectured at the City University from 1976 to 1985 and was the Dean of the Business School between 1982 and 1985. He was appointed a Director of the Bank of England in 1983 and Head of the Prime Minister's Policy Unit in 1985, responsible for domestic policy-making. He was made a life peer in 1991. Lord Griffiths is Vice Chairman of Goldman Sachs International and Director of Times Newspaper Holdings Ltd, Telewest Communications Group Limited and Herman Miller Inc. He also serves as Chairman of the Centre for Policy Studies and the Archbishop of Canterbury's Lambeth Fund.

Lord Griffiths has lectured and published on economic and public policy as well as on ethics and business.
