Matthew Bishop graduated from Oxford University with a degree in politics, philosophy and economics in 1986.

In 1991, Matthew Bishop joined The Economist as Economics Correspondent. He switched to the Britain Section as Britain Correspondent in 1994. Subsequently, in 1997, Matthew Bishop moved to New York to serve as American Finance Editor and was nominated New York Bureau Chief three years later. Since 2002, he has held the position as Business Editor, based in London.

Matthew Bishop is the author of “Essential Economics”, the official Economist guide to economics. Additionally, he is a Member of the Advisors Group for the United Nations Year of Microcredit.
