Born in 1951. Günter Müller-Stewens graduated in business administration from the University of Regensburg in 1977 and earned a doctorate from the University of Munich in 1981.

He started his academic career in 1978 as a research assistant at the Department of Statistics at the University of Munich, a position he held until becoming research assistant at the Institute for Organizational Science at the University of Munich in 1984. Günter Müller-Stewens earned his postdoctoral lecture qualification in 1986 at the University of Stuttgart before he was called to Duisburg University as professor of strategic planning, organisation and human resource management in 1987. He has been professor of management and organisation at the University of St. Gallen as well as Director of the Institute of Management since 1991.

Günter Müller-Stewens did research at Harvard Business School as well as at Stanford Business School and was a visiting professor at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, and at the University of California, Irvine.
