Born in 1957. Victor Chu received his early education in Hong Kong and England and earned his law degree at University College, London.

Since 1982, Victor Chu has practised in the field of corporate, commercial and securities law, with special emphasis on China and regional investment transactions. He is Senior Partner of Victor Chu & Co. and served as Deputy Secretary-General of the International Bar Association (IBA) from 1995 until 2000. He was appointed several times as part-time member of the Hong Kong government's central policy unit. In addition, Victor Chu served as Director and Council Member of the Hong Kong Stock Exchange, as Member of the Advisory Committee of the Securities and Futures Commission and as Member of the Hong Kong Takeovers and Mergers Panel. Victor Chu is Founder and Chairman of First Eastern Investment Group, a regional investment firm involved in the management of direct investments in China and the region of the Association of South-East Asian Nations (ASEAN), as well as of First Eastern Securities Limited and several other regional companies.

Victor Chu is also a Council Member of the World Economic Forum in Geneva and Chairman of the Paris-based ICC Commission on Financial Services and Insurance. Aside from his business activities, he serves on the Boards of the Asia Society, Asia House, the Institute of International Education and the East Asia Institute of Cambridge University.
