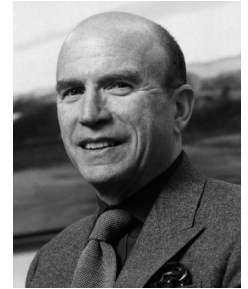

In addition to his business commitments, Carl Ferenbach is President and Co-Founder of High Meadows Funds and a Trustee of Environmental Defense. He is a past Director of the Alumni Board at Harvard Business School and a Member of the Board of Dean's Advisers of the Harvard Business School.
